

Outreach and Reintegration Service Charging Structure 2019-2020

Menu of Services

Primary and Secondary Student Support

Behaviour Support

6 week programme including all coordination, formal reviews and 1:1 support. **No charge** for this service for schools and academies located within the London Borough of Bexley. £650 for schools located in neighbouring local authorities.

Reintegration Support

12 week support including all coordination, formal reviews and 1:1 support. Not available to schools and academies outside the London Borough of Bexley.

No charge for this service.

Mainstream School and Academy Support

Planning Meetings

A two hour meeting in the mainstream school to discuss and plan intervention for children and young people at risk of exclusion.

Cost £150 (no limit to number of students discussed)

Behaviour Surgery

A two hour panel meeting with home school, parent and student to address behaviour concerns and formalise agreed way forward following the schools own pastoral programmes.

Cost £250 (maximum 4 meetings)

Restorative Conference

Impartial approach to resolve relationships difficulties between individual students or conflict between parents and school staff resulting from student behaviour in school. **Cost** £150

Anti-Bullying and Discriminatory Support

A review of the school's Anti-Bullying Policy and restorative and mediation work in relation to cases of alleged bullying or specific anti-social behaviour targeting individual or groups of students.

Cost £150 two hour review

Managed Move

Facilitated between Bexley secondary academies/ schools where a move has been agreed as appropriate through school based planning meetings. This includes the coordination and monitoring of progress over the 12 week programme.

Cost £750

Cross Borough Manage Moves

Including presenting the case at Fair Access Panels and Inclusion Forums, coordinating referrals, arranging initial and review meetings and overseeing a 6 week manage move process.

Cost £750

Primary and Secondary Assessments

Dyslexia and Dyscalculia Screening

Screening tests are designed to provide an indication of possible dyslexic difficulties which can be used to identify an area of support and as evidence for further testing and assessment.

Cost £50

Goodman's Strength and Difficulties Questionnaires

A screening tool exploring a young person's vulnerability to internalising or externalising emotion communicated through their behaviour. The SDQ explores emotional, conduct, hyperactivity, pro social and peer relationships.

Cost £50

Boxall Profile

A structured framework designed to assess the developmental, behavioural, social and cognitive engagement of children and young people within a classroom setting.

Cost £50

Targeted Support Programme

Social Communication Programme

A structured programme designed to help children and young people develop the social communication skills needed to positively interact with peers and adults and manage their emotional responses appropriately within the classroom setting.

Cost £500 maximum 6 students

Transition Support (Primary to Secondary)

A two hour interactive workshop followed by 3 sessions delivered in the home school. **Cost** £500 maximum 8 students

Accredited Peer Mentoring Programme

Training and support delivered by our accredited peer mentor coordinator. This includes full programme and resources.

Cost £650 maximum 10 mentors and 10 mentees

Substance Misuse Support Programme

A targeted programme to help students absorb the information, make better choices and avoid risk taking behaviour related to substance misuse.

Cost £500 maximum 8 students

Outward Bound Project

A 3 full day programme followed by 4 classroom sessions delivered in the home school. Includes programme, resources and travel.

Cost £850 maximum 8 students.

Targeted Outreach Programme

<u>Primary Project</u> (Year 6) including being a good citizen, keeping safe, social media, groups and gangs.

Cost £350 year group assembly

<u>Secondary Social Awareness Project</u>- 6 sessions delivered in the home school focussing on gangs, joint enterprise, anti-social behaviour, substance misuse and exploitation.

Cost £500 maximum 8 students

Training to Mainstream School Staff Teams

Exclusion from Schools and Academies

A full day training programme focussing on DFE Guidance and including Exclusion Process, Discipline Committee Meetings and Independent Review Panels.

Cost £750 unlimited number of attendees

Pastoral Support Programmes

A half day training session designed to introduce a programme of support that brings together parent/carers, school staff, students and relevant outside agencies.

Cost £375 unlimited number of attendees

Social Stories

A two part training session focusing on the use and creation of social stories and comic strip conversations.

Cost £350 maximum 10 attendees

Team Teach

Accredited Team Teach training includes the safe teaching of physical interventions, deescalation techniques and behavioural support taught to staff using the Team Teach framework.

Cost £1000 for up to 24 staff for a 1 day course or £1800 for a two day course. Please note: additional tutors may be required for larger parties. Each additional tutor required will be £400 per day per tutor.

Menu of Service

Education Health Care Plan Application Support

A two hour consultancy meeting with the Horizons Academy SENCO to review, plan and maximise success of applications referred to the statutory assessment panel.

Cost £250

Pastoral Support

A 6 week programme of combined support working in partnership with the home school team who will deliver the planned intervention to children and young people with ASD, ADHD and attachment disorders.

Cost £450

1:1 and Small Group Support

Interventions available include Social Skills, Social Stories and therapeutic approaches such as Lego Therapy and Drawing and Talking.

Cost £250 6 week or £500 12 week programme. Maximum 6 students.

KS1- KS2 Transition Programme

A 6 week programme designed to provide transitional support to students with SEND who may find moving to KS2 difficult.

Cost £250 maximum 6 students

SEN Consultation

A two hour consultancy meeting with the Head Teacher of Aspire SEMH Academy or Head Teacher of Endeavour SEMH Academy.

Cost £500
