

TARGETED OUTREACH PROJECT

The Targeted Outreach Project is a thought provoking and hard hitting programme designed to address the impact and reality of risk taking behaviours on vulnerable young people. Topics covered include substance misuse, offensive weapons, gangs and joint enterprise, exploitation, anti-social behaviour and county lines.

The programme targets specific challenges faced by young people whilst focussing on how to make positive life choices in order to improve life chances both in school and the community.

The Project offers three programmes which are accessible to schools and academies in the London Borough of Bexley.

- 'Social Awareness Programme ' A 6 session PSHE style programme targeting specific topics placing students at risk of exclusion,
- 'Myths and Realities of Risk taking Behaviours'- A one day workshop hosted by ex-offenders and victims of serious crime,
- 'Know the Signs!' Parent Workshop Identifying and addressing risk taking behaviour in young people.
